As a middle school Crusader, you participate in our **Core Requirements** and **Electives**. The schedule below shows the programs you can do, based on your grade. All our core requirements and electives are designed to help you make the most of your middle school years and to prepare you to go on to high school. Be sure to take advantage of everything you can!

***Notes:** **CAAP:** You need to do this requirement only once, and you can select in which grade you do it. It is offered October to December and March to May and in 2-week sessions over the summer.

Cru Club: You must complete 10 hours of Cru Club each academic year. You can complete your required hours after school if you attend a school with an Advisor, or you can attend Saturday Cru Club.

Career Exploration: You must participate in one career visit, career day, or guest speaker before leaving middle school. Crusaders can participate in other career exploration opportunities through Cru Club.
